What is Clean Fleet Connect?

- An upcoming webtool to connect shippers, brokers & BCOs with zero-emission fleets ready for hire

Key Points

- Open to medium and heavy-duty fleets
- Fleet participation is **voluntary**
- Launching Mid 2026



Clean Fleet Connect Basics

Clean Fleet Connect would:

- Showcase voluntary early-action zero-emission fleets
- Improve visibility for participating fleets
- Support sustainability efforts

Clean Fleet Connect would **not**:

- Create regulatory requirements or affect compliance
- Provide guaranteed business or financial benefits
- Endorse or recommend any specific entity

Web Tool Concept

Web App and Sign up

- Hosted on a dedicated webpage
- User-friendly, public list of participating fleets
 - Search and filter options
- Regular data updates

Displayed Fleet Information

- Business/Agency Name
- Fleet Type (Government, For Hire Carrier, Private Carrier)
- Number of ZEVs by Fuel Type and Vehicle Class
- Percent of Fleet that is ZEV
- Truck Operation Type and Region of Service
- Public Contact Information

Proposed Tier Fleet Recognition Framework

- Three Tiers: Bronze, Silver and Gold
- Designed to reflect different stages of ZEV adoption
- Based on:
 1. ZEV Adoption
 2. Progress toward ZEV share, following defined ZE adoption milestones
 3. Annual update of fleet information

Proposed Fleet Benefits

Recognition & Visibility

- Highlighted in a public tool or platform
- Ability to showcase participation through program branding
- Certificate of recognition
- Featured through web or social channels
- Potential eligibility for further CARB recognition

Networking Opportunities

- Opportunities to connect with industry partners
- Access to informational workshops and resources

California Clean Construction Program Purpose

- 2022 State Strategy for the State Implementation Plan measure
- Intended to reduce emissions from off-road equipment and increase use of zero-emission equipment



California Clean Construction Users

- Awarding bodies such as:
 - Municipalities
 - Districts
 - Regional Agencies and Association of Governments
 - Private Industry and Organizations



California Clean Construction Program



- Voluntary, non-monetary incentive
- Provides a standardized measure for construction projects to reduce emissions
- Projects reduce emissions with use of zero-emission equipment
- Provides recognition for awarding body and contractor
- California Environmental Quality Act mitigation measure eligible

Implementation












- The awarding body implements the program, maintains flexibility to add additional conditions specific to their project, and grants eligible exceptions.

Zero-Emission Equipment List

California Clean Construction requires the use of zero-emission construction equipment.

- List of zero-emission off-road construction equipment types available for lease, rent, or purchase in California
- California Clean Construction Zero-Emission Equipment List updated regularly

Zero-Emission Equipment List

- Aerial Lift (scissor or personnel) 
- Compact/Mini Excavator (up to 15,000 lbs. operating weight) 
- Compact /Mini track and wheel loaders (up to 15,000 lbs. operating weight) 
- Dumper/Buggy 
- Forklift (up to 5,000 lbs. lift capacity) 
- Light cart/tower/stand 
- Power generation systems, Battery Energy Storage Systems 
- Tampers/Mini-Compactors/Mini-Rollers 
- Walk-behind concrete saw 



Status

- Program is complete and is available for immediate participation
- Conducting outreach including mailers, emails, direct engagements, and more
- Supporting and planning for early projects
